#### TIMMEN HISTORICAL DATES

On December 7, 1875 John H. Timmen officially recorded the town site of La Center, WA.

John Herman Timmen died on June 17, 1918 in Chinook, WA

Horace Jacob Timmen (son of founder) was born on June 21, 1888 in La Center, WA

John Frederic Timmen (son of Horace Jacob) died on May 28, 1983 in Kennewick, WA

## Timmen's Landing Bench



On December 7, 1875 John H. Timmen officially recorded the town site of La Center, Territory of Washington, County of Clarke, in Plat Book A, page 4. Shortly after that, the Lewis and Lake River Navigation Company was formed by several town leaders who had a sternwheeler built for regular service from La Center to Portland along the East and North Forks of the Lewis River. Scows transported railroad ties, firewood and logs to the Portland Market. The Town of La Center was the major provider of railroad ties on the West Coast. All of this activity occurred at Timmen's Landing now used for launching watercraft and enjoying water activities. The city of La Center by request of the La Center Historical Museum has placed a bench commemorating Timmen's Landing as a special part of the town's history.




